UTILITY PAYMENT REPOSE PLAN TO COVID-19

On March 24, 2020 the City Council of the City of Wray declared a Local Disaster Emergency in response to the COVID-19 pandemic that warrants the mobilizing of emergency response and the furnishing of aid and assistance by the City of Wray. During this time event, the City of Wray will not disconnect service(s) or assess reconnection and late fees while the community responds to COVID-19.

The City of Wray recognizes that orders from the State of Colorado in response to the pandemic limit the operations of certain businesses and other recommendations and guidance from the federal and state governments is likely to have a significant financial impact to the citizens of Wray. As such, the City has implemented a temporary program to allow customers to request a delay in payment or partial payment arrangement of their City utility bill. A customer requesting payment delay arrangement must complete this form in its entirety and return it to City Hall by mail, email, or by use of the drop box locations at City Hall.
