



City of Wray Right-of-Way Permit Application Checklist

1. Please give 48 hour advance notice.
2. Contact the Utility Notification Center of Colorado for utility locates at 1-800-922-1987.
3. As built maps shall be provided to the City within sixty (60) days from the date of the City's acceptance of the work (*Section 12.20.090*).
4. Provide to the City a Certificate of Insurance (*Section 12.20.100*).
5. Provide to the City a Performance Bond or Letter of Credit. If a public utility, a Letter of Responsibility may be accepted in lieu of a Performance Bond or Letter of Credit (*Section 12.20.110*).
6. By accepting the permit, the applicant warrants and guarantees all work done by him/her for a period of three (3) years after the City's acceptance of the work (*Section 12.20.120*).
7. An inspection of the work will be performed by the City immediately after the work is complete and three (3) years after the date of acceptance (*Section 12.20.130*).
8. All work covered by the permit shall be completed within six (6) months after the date of issuance (*Section 12.20.150*).
9. A Traffic Control Plan shall be submitted to the City as necessary (*Section 12.20.160*).

All Sections refer to Sections of the Wray Municipal Code, Title 12, Streets and Sidewalks, Chapter 20, Public Rights-of-Way.
